POLICY:

Students are advised that clinical experiences in Brandon, Winnipeg, the surrounding area or other areas in the province/locations is an essential part of the program. Students are responsible for all expenses incurred, for example: transportation, room and board.

Students are responsible for complying with the policies of any agency selected for clinical experience.

Prior to participating in clinical practice experiences, students must have the following on file:

- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector search, Child Abuse Registry Check and Adult Abuse Registry Check
- Current Immunization Record
- Nonviolent Crisis Intervention® (NVC) Certification
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) Certification
- Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) Certification
- Personal Health Information Act (PHIA) orientation session and signing of Pledge of Confidentiality

Additional clinical site specific or program specific training/certifications may be required. Examples include, but are not limited to:

- Safe Client Handling
- N95 mask fit testing
- Electronic Patient Record (EPR) training
- Hearing Voices workshop with the Manitoba Schizophrenia Society (MSS)
- Automated Medication Distribution System (AMDS) – PYXIS
- Winnipeg Regional Health Authority (WRHA) Clinical Placement Agreement Appendix A
- WRHA learning modules
