The goal of senior practicum is to integrate theory with practice and hone critical thinking and clinical skills. These goals can be managed effectively during placements within the provinces of Manitoba and Saskatchewan.

We recognize there may be circumstances or opportunities that necessitate placement outside of Manitoba and Saskatchewan. Possible criteria for approval may include but not limited to: family, domestic, or military situation.

Out of Province Senior Practicum placement requests will be considered on an individual basis.

Requests for international placements will not be considered.

## PROCESS:

- 1) The student must provide a letter to the Clinical Placement Coordinator outlining the rationale for requesting an out of province senior practicum request by June 1 of the year preceding the senior practicum.
- 2) The student request letter will be reviewed by the Course Faculty for Senior Practicum, in consultation with Clinical Placement Coordinators. The Department Chair will be consulted if necessary. Approval or denial will be granted in writing by the Course Faculty. Previous clinical performance will be taken into consideration.
- 3) If approved, Faculty in 69.442 will communicate with student/preceptor through phone, email, virtual meetings, and/or other methods of communication.
