Master of Education: Inclusive Education

The Inclusive Education specialization prepares educators to be school leaders in the practice of inclusive education and resource implementation. The program emphasizes a disability lens to understand and undo difference, stigma, and to support current positive inclusive practices. In addition to the Master of Education degree, it also provides the foundation for the Manitoba Special Education Certificate.

Students completing our Master of Education in Inclusive Education program often choose the course route to meet Special Education Teaching Certificate requirements; this route typically requires three years to complete. For students considering a thesis, note that acceptance into the thesis route depends on 15 credit hours of exceptional academic performance in our program. Also, the opportunity to pursue the thesis route depends on the availability and suitability of a thesis advisor from the Department of Educational Psychology and Student Services.

Students enrolled in the Master of Education in Inclusive Education program take courses through distance delivery. Courses delivered at a distance require a webinar platform (currently Zoom) and are conducted synchronously during the evening (based on Central Standard Time). Students may also need to take coursework, such as those focused on the use of standardized test instruments or counselling processes, via face-to-face learning at Brandon University. Attendance during face-to-face and synchronous webbased courses is required to complete this program.
