The Brandon University Research Ethics Committee (BUREC) offers helpful resources on its webpage to assist you when preparing your ethics application. A recent addition to the resource listing is from Portage. Portage was launched by the Canadian Association of Research Libraries (CARL) “to contribute to the shared stewardship of research data and address specific gaps in national research data management infrastructure in Canada”. Specific to human participatory research, the Sensitive Data Expert Group developed a Sensitive Data Toolkit for Researchers “to help researchers understand how research data is involved in the research ethics process, and to address the evolution of research data management (RDM) practices such as data sharing and deposit in the context of existing research ethics frameworks.” The toolkit includes:

- Part 1: Glossary of Terms for Sensitive Data used for Research Purposes
- Part 2: Human Participant Research Data Risk Matrix
- Part 3: Research Data Management Language for Informed Consent
