Steps to Perform This Task Safely:

	Instructions	Photo
Pre-use	Inspect and don all required PPE.	
1.	Spray entire surface with cleaner.	
CAUTION	Hot Water	
2.	Turn cold water on and bring to lukewarm temperature by adjusting the hot water.	
CAUTION	There is the potential for chemicals to splash.	
3.	Wet a re-useable cloth and wipe cleaner off the surface slowly to avoid splashing and knocking your hand on the hard surfaces and fixtures.	
4.	Ensure the cloth is touching the surface of the sink to protect yourself from any edges on fixtures.	
5.	Rinse the sink with clean water.	
6.	Shut off water taps.	
7.	Let sink air dry.	
8.	Mop up any water that may be on the floor.
